Robert Schley Fahle was born in St. Louis, Missouri, and moved to Houston, Texas, where he graduated from elementary and high school.

Captain Fahle has a meritorious record dating back to his graduation from the U. S. Naval Academy, class of '31. His campaigns and operations include: North African Invasion, November 1942, Occupation of Saipan, June 1944, Bombardment of Marcus Island, October 1944, and participation in the Second Battle of the Philippine Sea, October 1944.

Captain Fahle served as commanding officer of the USS PRAIRIE from 12 March 1955 to 30 November 1956. He is now serving as the U. S. Naval Attache, Mexico City.
