## VICE ADMIRAL C.D. GRIFFIN COMMANDER SEVENTH FLEET

Vice Admiral Charles D. Griffin was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on January 12, 1906. He was commissioned Ensign on June 2, 1927 and became a naval aviator in June 1930 at Pensacola, Florida. He assumed command of the SEVENTH Fleet on March 7, 1960.
