

CAPT TODD W. BOSTOCK

COMMANDING OFFICER, USS MONTEREY (CG 61)

Captain Todd W. Bostock, United States Navy, is the son of the late Owen E. Bostock, Sr. and Donna J. and Andy Tvardzik of Windber, PA. Captain Bostock graduated from Windber Area High School, Class of 1979, and the U.S. Naval Academy, Class of 1983, with a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science.

Captain Bostock is also a graduate of the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA, where he was awarded a degree of Master of Science in Applied Science (Anti-Submarine Warfare) in 1990.

Captain Bostock's sea duty assignments include USS CLAUDE V. RICKETTS (DDG 5), homeported in Norfolk, VA as Anti-Submarine Warfare Officer and later, Main Propulsion Assistant; Engineer Officer in USS NICHOLAS (FFG 47), homeported in Charleston, SC; Commissioning Engineer Officer in USS PORT ROYAL (CG 73), constructed in Pascagoula, MS and later homeported in Pearl Harbor, HI; Assistant Surface Operations Officer in Commander, Cruiser-Destroyer Group TWELVE, homeported in Mayport, FL; Executive Officer in USS PLATTE (AO 186), homeported in Norfolk, VA; and Chief Staff Officer for Commander, Destroyer Squadron TWO, homeported in Norfolk, VA.

Captain Bostock's shore duty assignments include Assistant Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans (N3/N5) for Commander, Naval Surface Force, U.S. Atlantic Fleet in Norfolk, VA and the Joint Staff, Directorate for C4I Systems



(J6) in Washington, DC, where he first served as the Deputy Division Chief for the Assured Information Sharing division (J6X) and later as the Division Chief for the Command and Control Functional Capabilities Board (C2 FCB).

Captain Bostock served as Commanding Officer of USS HAWES (FFG 53) from June 2001 until June 2003. While he was in command, HAWES participated in NATO Exercise STRONG RESOLVE 2002 in the Baltic Sea and later, deployed to the Mediterranean Sea with the HARRY S. TRUMAN Carrier Strike Group,

where HAWES served as the U.S. representative to Standing Naval Forces Mediterranean during Operations ACTIVE ENDEAVOR and IRAQI FREEDOM. During his command tour, HAWES was selected as the Destroyer Squadron TWENTY TWO Battle "E" winner for CY2002 and CY2003.

Captain Bostock assumed command of USS MONTEREY (CG 61) on 12 Oct 2007. MONTEREY is homeported in Norfolk, VA and serves as the Air Defense Commander for the THEODORE ROOSEVELT Carrier Strike Group.

Captain Bostock has been awarded the Defense Superior Service Medal, two Meritorious Service Medals, Navy-Marine Corps Commendation Medal, (5 awards) the Navy-Marine Corps Achievement Medal, the Combat Action Ribbon, and various unit and service awards.
