LCDR Jeffrey Hickox joined the Navy on 7 July 1986. He attended the United States Naval Academy, where he graduated in 1990 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in General Engineering. After completing nuclear power training in May of 1992, he reported to USS Gary (FFG-61) as Antisubmarine Warfare Officer. In January 1994, he transferred to the USS Enterprise (CVN-65) as Assistant Damage Control Assistant. From February 1996 through March 1998 he attended Naval Postgraduate School, where he received a Masters of Operations Research Degree while performing research at Recruit Training Command.

After attending Department Head School in February 1999, he was assigned to USS Chancellorsville (CG-62) as Weapons Officer.
