

Lieutenant Commander MYERS, a native of Evanston, Illinois was commissioned in 1970 through the Regular NROTC program following graduation from Yale University with a B.S. in Physics. His first tour of duty was as Communications Officer on USS JOHNSTON (DD 821). He was subsequently assigned as Operations/Readiness Officer Staff, COMDESRON FOUR from February 1972 until June 1974. Following forty-seven weeks of Turkish Language Training at the Defense Language Institute, Monterey, California, Commander MYERS served as Personal Aide/Special Projects Officer for Chief, Navy Section, JUSMMAT, Ankara, Turkey from July 1975 to August 1977. Next came assignment to SWOSCOLCOM, Newport, Rhode Island for attendance at the Department Head Course. Following Newport, Lieutenant Commander MYERS received orders to USS REEVES (CG 24) serving as Operations Officer from June 1978 to November 1980.

From December 1980 to June 1982, Lieutenant Commander MYERS attended the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California, from which he earned an M.A. (with distinction) in National Security Affairs, winning the Naval Institute Award for his professional achievement.
