Commander Pierpont was born in Boston, Massachusetts on 7 July 1944. In 1963 he enlisted in the Air Reserve and continued to participate actively while attending the University of Vermont. In 1967, Commander Pierpont received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Languages and a commission through the Reserve Officer Candidate Program.
