

Captain Jack E. Magee, U.S.N.

COMMANDING OFFICER

Captain Magee was born on 25 September 1925 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and was commissioned an Ensign in the United States Navy upon graduating from the U. S. Naval Academy in 1949.

Since accepting his commission, Captain Magee has served on the USS MAC-KENZIE (DD-836), deploying to the Mediterranean and Western Pacific; Submarine School, New London as a student; USS REQUIN (SSR-481) and USS JALLAO (SS-368) as Gunnery, Operations and Engineering Officer; General Line School, Monterey, California as a student; and Bureau of Naval Personnel in Allowance/Complement Officer-Requirement Division. From Washington, Captain Magee was assigned to the Commissioning Detail of the USS BAR-BEL (SS-580) as Navigation/Operations Officer; USS CUBERA (SS-347) as Executive and Commanding Officer; and was then assigned as Commanding Officer of the USS GRENADIER (SS-525). Captain Magee joined the Joint Staff of CIN-CLANT as Assistant Operations-Plans Officer for the POLARIS in 1964, and in 1966 was assigned to the Staff of COM-SUBRON FIFTEEN as Chief Staff Officer until May of 1968. Captain Magee reports to HECTOR from duties as Executive Officer of the Fleet Submarine Training Facility, Pearl Harbor.

Captain Magee was married in 1954 to the former Nancy Zinzert of Dayton, Ohio. They have two children; Charlott, 15 and William, 3.
