Captain Brown served as Flag Secretary for the Supreme Allied Commander, Atlantic/Commander in Chief, United States Joint Forces Command from February 2000 to July 2002.

Captain Brown's most recent assignment was Branch Head for Surface Commander and Lieutenant Commander Assignments, Navy Personnel Command, PERS 410, from April 2005 through August 2007.
