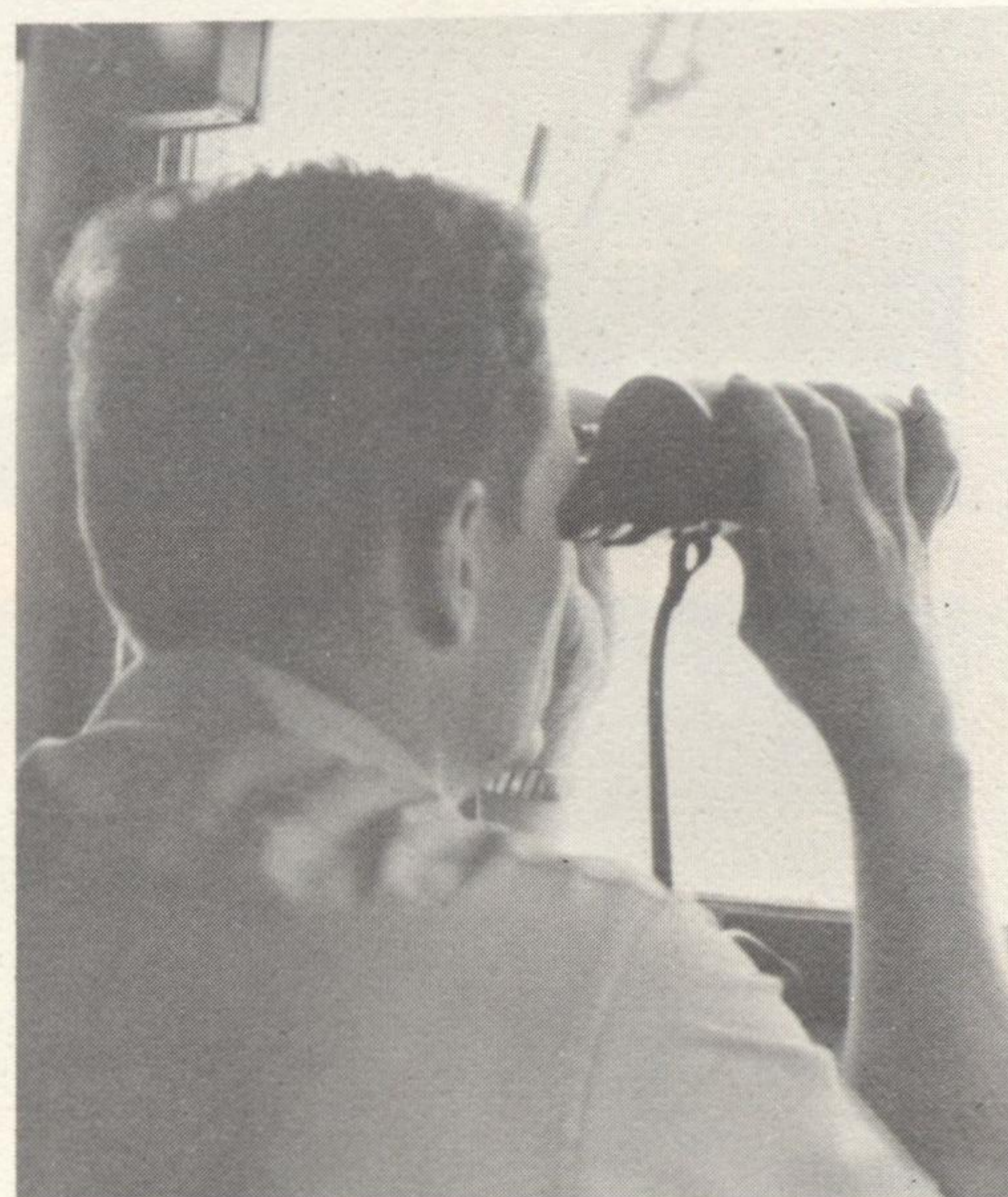


COMMANDER DESTROYER DIVISION 122
