COMMANDER KEVIN J. KELLEY

Commander Kevin J. Kelley was commissioned an Ensign from the NROTC Unit, University of Texas, on 25 May 1973.

Following graduation Commander Kelley reported aboard USS ALBERT DAVID (FF-1050) where he served as Gunnery Assistant and First Lieutenant. In August 1986, Commander Kelley reported to the USS ALBANY (CG-10) as Naval Tactical Data Systems Officer. From April 1978 to March 1981 Commander Kelley attended the U.S. Naval Post Graduate School where he graduated with a Master of Science in Operations Research followed by assignment to Surface Warfare Department Head School.

After graduation he was assigned as Chief Engineer on board USS PAUL (FF-1080). In December
